For his collective and individual contribution to the League Joe was awarded the Badge of Honour in 1967 and made a Life Member in 1957.

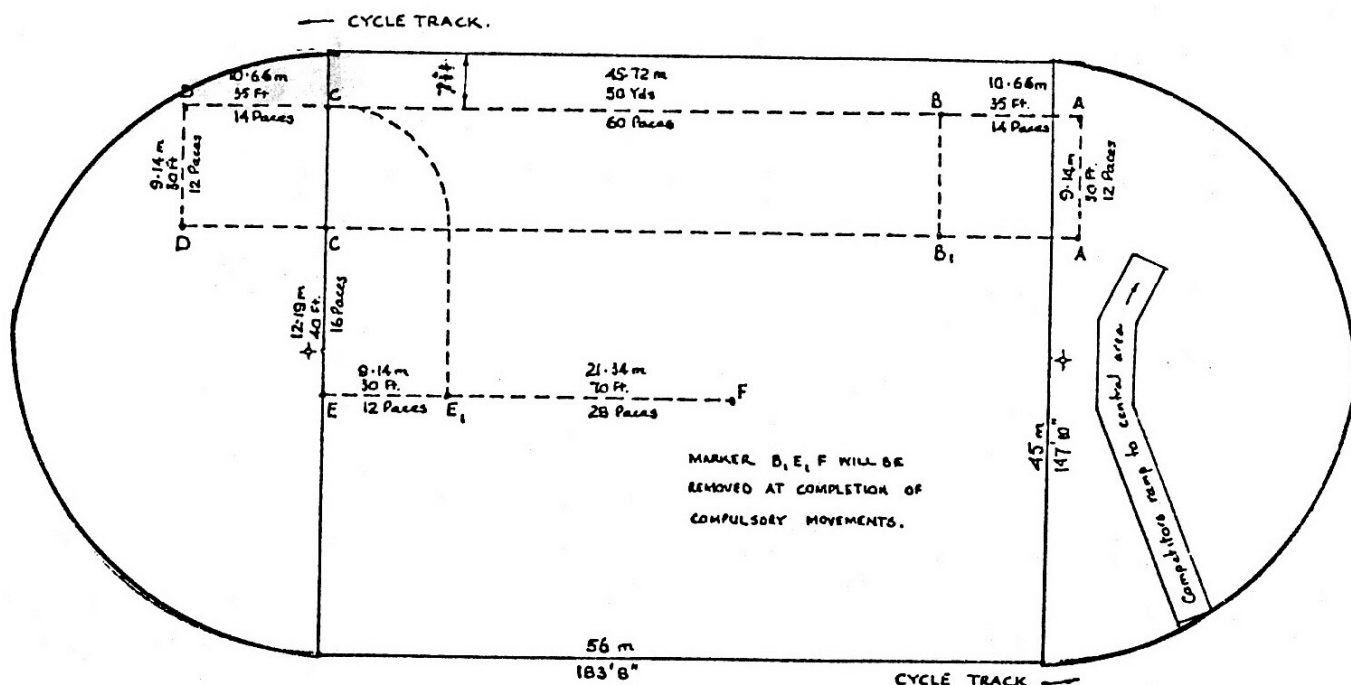

LAUNCESTON VELODROME



SEATING AREA PUBLIC
FRONT ENTRANCE

1. For inspection, Band will fall in with right marker on Point F. Drum Major allowed 3 minutes to prepare band for inspection and Adjudicator allowed 4 minutes for inspection.
2. Composition of Band: 18-25 instrumentalists plus percussion.
3. Positioning of percussion is optional.
4. Inspection will be conducted in marching formation.
5. NBC rules will apply in respect to movements until after right turn at F.
6. Pacing and timing will be effective from B.B. to C.C.
7. Time for Diagram and Own Choice Display will be a minimum of 3 minutes and maximum of 8 minutes, and display must be carried out within the prescribed area of 56 x 45 metres.

Band will fall in at A.A. and move off in quick time to D.D.
On arrival at D.D., the band will counter march from front to rear, flank to flank, then right turn and march to C.C.
At C.C. band will right wheel and march to point E.E.
At E.E. band will left turn and march to point F.
At F. band will right turn and proceed with own display.
