## President's Message:-

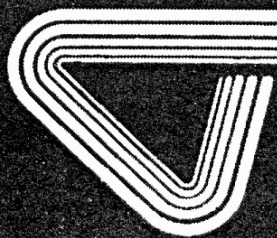
